Impaired driving

'Sand Man' 101



We find many amateur players are unclear about how to play the greenside sand shot. From a normal lie, wiggle your feet lightly into the sand for good traction, your weight evenly distributed. The ball should be opposite your left heel. Set your hands slightly behind the ball, so the face of your sand wedge is "laid-back," with slightly more loft than normal. You want to make a swing in which the flange of your wedge "spanks" the sand, a full 2 inches behind the ball. Focus and aim for this spot behind the ball, rather than the ball itself. Alter the length and the force of your swing for the distance you have to the flag. Finally, make sure to follow through, spanking the sand, and your ball will pop up and out nicely.

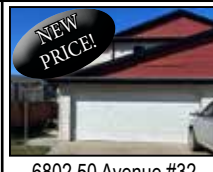

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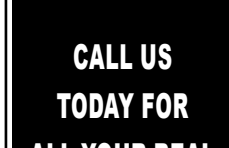

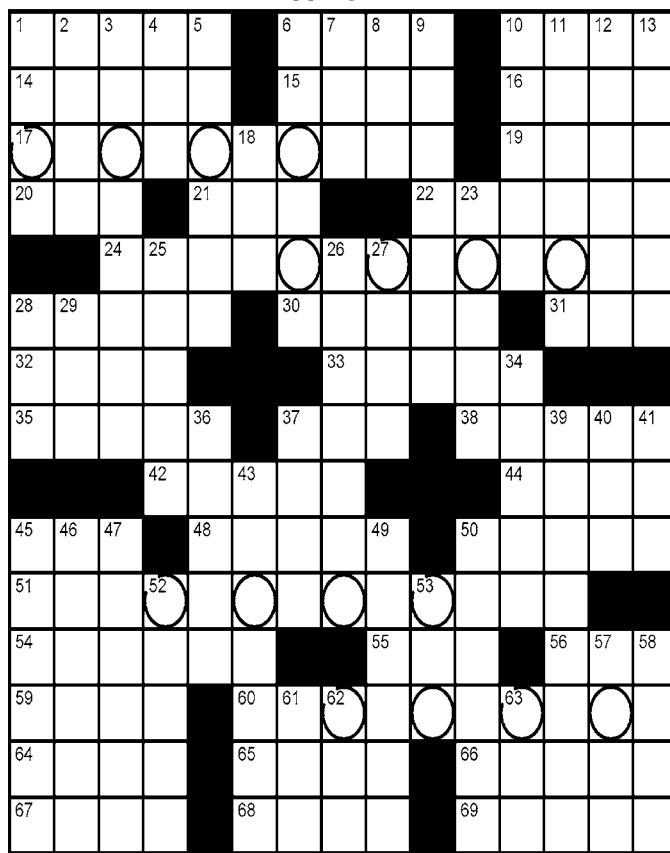

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THE MORNING BITE

Gypsy Soup

The vegetables used in this soup are flexible. Any orange vegetable can be combined with green. Such as peas or green beans to replace peppers, or carrots and/or squash to replace the sweet potato.

Prep time: 40 min

Cook time: 30 min

Servings: 4

Ingredients

- 3 Tbsp Olive Oil
- 2 cup Chopped Onion
- 2 cloves Chopped Garlic
- 2 cup Sweet Potatoes, chopped and peeled
- 1/2 cup Chopped Celery
- 1 cup Chopped Fresh Tomatoes
- 3/4 cup Chopped Sweet Peppers
- 1-1/2 cup Cooked Chickpeas
- 3 cup Stock or Water
- 2 tsp Paprika
- 1 tsp Turmeric
- 1 tsp Basil
- 1 tsp Salt
- dash Cinnamon
- dash Cayenne
- 1 Bay Leaf
- 1 Tbsp Tamari Soy Sauce



Directions

In a soup kettle or large saucepan, saute onions garlic, celery, and sweet potatoes in olive oil for about five minutes.

Add seasonings, except tamari, and the stock/water. Simmer covered, for fifteen minutes.

Add remaining vegetables, chickpeas, and tamari.

Simmer another 10 minutes or so - until all the vegetables are as tender as you like them.

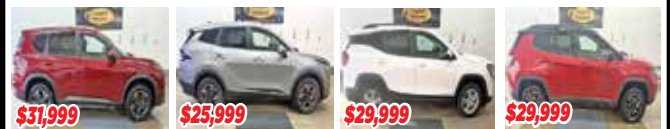

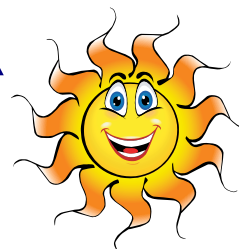
