

Hit and run on vehicle

A person reported their vehicle was hit by another vehicle while parked outside their residence and the subject vehicle left the scene. The person indicated the incident was recorded on their CCTV.

Break in and theft from vehicle

A person reported the back window of their vehicle was smashed out while it was parked in the area of the offleash dog park. Bank cards were stolen from the vehicle and used unlawfully.

Stolen commercial vacuum

A representative of a local gas bar reported the gas bar vacuum had gone missing and review of CCTVideo revealed a dark truck pull up in the early morning, someone exit the truck and take the vacuum. Still under investigation.

Collision between train and vehicle

Police assisted RCMP at a report of a collision between a passenger vehicle and train north of Highway 13 bordering Camrose and Camrose County. No injuries reported.

Counterfeit \$100

A local retail store manager attended Camrose Police Station and turned in a counterfeit \$100 bill, which they indicated was told to be counterfeit by the bank. The person reported receiving the bill some time between November 14-15.

Attempted break in

Stabbing

Business vacuum stolen





The Bailey Theatre Society is launching its new fundraising initiative:

The seats in our balcony are in need of replacement as they are beyond repair. Theatre seating, unlike fine wine, doesn't get better with age, and these seats are past their best before date. The current balcony seats were in Edmonton's Citadel Theatre, which opened in 1975. When they were replaced in 2007, the Citadel gave permission to the Bailey volunteers to choose and remove the best ones. They were stored and later installed in 2010. These 50-year-old seats are 25 years past the normal life expectancy.

A Canadian manufacturer has provided a quote to supply and install new seats, complete with cup holders. All totalled, the project will cost \$96,000. That's where you come in. Help us restore the balcony. Help us continue to make the Bailey Theatre a sparkling jewel in the heart of Camrose. More than 10,550 people came to the Bailey in the past year. 

Seriously simple

A tasty take on butternut squash

Chef and culinary storyteller Pyet DeSpain has penned a lovely new book called "Rooted in Fire." It explores DeSpain's deeply personal journey through Native American and Mexican traditions, ancestral wisdom, and healing foodways. This book is part memoir, recipes and ceremony — a fascinating take on Native American and Mexican cuisine.

Here, the author shares a recipe that she first tasted in Valle de Guadalupe, Mexico, that she reinterpreted with her own touch. This would make a wonderful side dish surprise for holiday parties. To make this simple recipe, halve and seed the butternut squash, then bake it with melted butter, honey, habanero pepper, cumin, smoked paprika, salt, and pepper. The butternut squash becomes golden brown and caramelized, tasting sweet, savory and spicy all at once.

You can use this melted butter glaze on other favorite vegetables. If you aren't a fan of very hot chiles, you could add a jalapeno or simple green chile in place of the very hot habanero. You can also add a few sprigs of cilantro and a cut lime as a garnish.

Honey and Habanero Roasted Butternut Squash (Serves 4)

3 tablespoons unsalted butter

2 tablespoons honey

1 habanero pepper, finely minced (adjust to taste for desired heat)

1 teaspoon ground cumin

1/2 teaspoon smoked paprika

Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper, to taste

1 medium butternut squash, halved lengthwise and seeded

Fresh parsley or cilantro leaves, for garnish (optional)

Lime quarters, optional

- 1. Preheat the oven to 400 F.
- 2. In a small saucepan over low heat, melt the butter. Add the honey, habanero pepper, ground cumin, smoked paprika, and salt and pepper to taste. Stir well to combine, simmer for 5 minutes, and remove from the heat.
- 3. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper, place the butternut squash halves on the sheet cut-side up, and pour the butter mixture over the squash flesh.
- 4. Roast for 35 to 45 minutes, or until the edges are golden brown and the squash is tender. Remove the squash from the oven and let it cool slightly, about 5 minutes. Cut into four pieces, garnish with fresh parsley or cilantro leaves, lime quarters, if desired, and serve.



National Leadership on Local Issues: Getting Results for Battle River—Crowfoot

By the Hon. Pierre Poilievre, MP for Battle River—Crowfoot and Leader of the Conservative Party of Canada

Since you elected me as your Member of Parliament, my mission has been clear: provide national leadership on local issues that affect Battle River—Crowfoot. But slogans don't fix fences. Action is needed, and I am pleased to work with our federal Conservative team to take the grit, common sense and determination of rural Alberta and turn them into real results.

I want to give you a few of the many examples of how our team is delivering on this promise. We are taking the specific challenges you face—on your farms, in your businesses, and in your communities—and turning them into policies that unlock Canada's true potential.

First, we are fighting to unleash our economy. For too long, growth-killing Liberal taxes have punished farmers and other business owners when they can least afford it. Last year, the net income of Canadian farmers dropped by \$4.2 billion compared to 2023, while farm debt rose 14.1%—the highest annual increase in over 40 years. That is why I proposed the Canada First Reinvestment Tax Cut. The plan is simple: if you sell an asset and reinvest the proceeds into a Canadian business, farm, or home, you will pay no capital gains tax on that reinvestment. This would be economic rocket fuel for our riding. It would mean that money stays here—hiring local workers and buying new equipment—rather than being taxed away by Ottawa.

Second, we delivered on your freedom to repair your own equipment. When your tractor breaks down during harvest, you shouldn't be forced to wait weeks for a corporate technician to plug in a laptop. That is why we supported C-244 in the last Parliament, the "right to repair" bill, championed by Conservative MP Jeremy Patzer. This legislation updated the *Copyright Act* to ensure you can diagnose, maintain, and repair the machinery you own without digital locks getting in your way.

Third, we are tackling the violent crime wave threatening our communities. I know that for many of you, the fear of violent repeat offenders is real. That is why our team has introduced Bill C-242, the *Jail Not Bail Act*, sponsored by Arpan Khanna. This vital

legislation would stop the "catch-and-release" justice system created by the Liberals. It introduces a new "Major Offences" category for crimes like extortion and home invasion and creates a reverse onus on bail—meaning violent criminals will have to prove why they should be released, rather than the Crown having to prove they should be detained.

Fourth, we are prioritizing the rights of victims. My colleague Dane Lloyd has championed "McCann's Law," in honour of Lyle and Marie McCann of St. Albert. This legislation fights for a "No Body, No Parole" standard, ensuring that killers who refuse to disclose the location of their victims' remains face tougher penalties. It is a matter of basic decency: victims' families deserve closure, and criminals should not be rewarded for their cruelty.

Outside Parliament, we are fighting the out-of-touch bureaucracy on the ground, literally. I have heard from many of you about the devastation caused by gophers. Ottawa's decision to ban effective pest control products like strychnine was made by bureaucrats who put ideology over evidence. John Barlow, Conservative Shadow Minister for Agriculture, Saskatchewan MP Steven Bonk, and I are actively pressuring the government to grant the use of strychnine. We demand that the Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) base their decisions on agronomic reality, not activism.

Finally, I want to mention my friend and your former MP, Damien Kurek. During the last campaign, he and I travelled thousands of kilometres across this vast region together. From town halls in Consort, to kitchen tables in Camrose, to regular calls with local leaders, we heard the same message: you want a government that respects your work and protects your community.

Damien served this constituency with integrity and honour, and he remains a vital part of our movement. Damien and I, and the entire Conservative team, are united. We will not stop until we bring home a Canada that rewards hard work, respects rural communities, and puts its people first.

We are fighting for Canada. We are fighting for you.






