The Bailey Theatre Society is launching its new fundraising initiative:

BOOST THE BALCONY

The seats in our balcony are in need of replacement as they are beyond repair. Theatre seating, unlike fine wine, doesn't get better with age, and these seats are past their best before date. The current balcony seats were in Edmonton's Citadel Theatre, which opened in 1975. When they were replaced in 2007, the Citadel gave permission to the Bailey volunteers to choose and remove the best ones. They were stored and later installed in 2010. These 50-year-old seats are 25 years past the normal life expectancy.

A Canadian manufacturer has provided a quote to supply and install new seats, complete with cup holders. All totalled, the project will cost \$96,000. That's where you come in. 


