**JANUARY 8-15, 2026**

**Criminal flight**

Police conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for an equipment violation. Police observed a bag of cocaine on the person of the driver. Police seized the bag containing the cocaine and told the driver they were under arrest. The driver fled from police in the vehicle northbound on 53 Street. RCMP were notified. The matter is still under investigation.

**Bank alarm**

Police responded to a burglary alarm at a local bank. Police were unable to contact the keyholder. The doors of the building were found secure.

**Vehicle obstructing traffic**

Police responded to complaints of a vehicle causing issues at the intersection of 68 Street and 48 Avenue. Police spoke with the registered owner of the subject vehicle. The vehicle was towed immediately to ensure traffic safety.

**Abandoned vehicle**

A person reported an abandoned vehicle behind the City of Camrose recreation centre. Police attended and determined the vehicle was the same vehicle involved in the criminal flight the night before. Police identified the registered owner from documents inside the vehicle and also discovered an unspent .22 calibre shell. The vehicle was towed. This matter is still under investigation.

**Careless driving**

A person reported a vehicle nearly striking a pedestrian. Police located the subject vehicle and determined the operator of the subject vehicle was driving carelessly, lost control of the vehicle ending up on the front lawn of a residence located at 45 Avenue near Mount Pleasant. The operator of the vehicle was charged with careless driving, unregistered vehicle and driving with learner's licence without supervision.

**JANUARY 16-22, 2026**

**Checkstop**

Police conducted a checkstop at Highway 13 and 13A. Approximately 50 vehicles were checked and there were no concerns.

**Criminal flight**

Police located a stolen vehicle at a local convenience store being fueled by a male. As police attempted to stop the male he quickly drove off in the truck westbound out of Camrose. RCMP were notified. This matter is still under investigation.

**Dog attack**

A person reported their dog was attacked by another dog (unknown who owned the attacking dog). Community Peace Officer is investigating.

**Theft of fuel**

An employee of a local business reported damage (approximately \$230) to the gas cap of a diesel truck parked outside the business and approximately \$100 worth of fuel stolen.

**Theft from vehicle**

A person reported that on January 18, their vehicle was broken into while parked in the parking lot of the indoor arena. Several items, including: a radar detector, an iPad, purse and gift cards were taken. The person reported that the rear passenger door of the vehicle was damaged.

**Stolen truck**

A person reported that their 1995 truck was stolen outside of their business. Sometime later a report was received about a truck entering the ditch a few kilometres northeast of Camrose. Police attended and recovered the truck.

**Impaired driver**

Police conducted a traffic stop. The operator of the vehicle failed a Mandatory Alcohol Screening test and was issued an Immediate Roadside Sanction.

**Collision**

A person reported a vehicle colliding with a street sign on a median. The person provided police with a description of the operator and the licence plate number of the subject vehicle. Police identified the registered owner of the subject vehicle and attended their residence. Subject admitted to driving the vehicle and causing the collision.

**Scam**

A person reported being defrauded out of approximately \$6,200 from a scammer claiming to be with a cell phone provider indicating the person's reporting account was being changed, specifically their address, requesting personal information for confirmation.





## Enjoy this yummy alternative to classic gazpacho

Gazpacho usually means a tomato-based soup with bread and cucumbers. In Spain there is an offshoot of the tomatoey-garlic soup called Salmorejo, which uses plenty of olive oil to emulsify it all together.

Tasty, but richer, Salmorajo can be found in Cordoba, Spain, where the summers are unbearably hot. The locals keep this refrigerated soup at the ready for a satisfying and cool meal. In the same way that Spanish white gazpacho features cucumbers and grapes, this white gazpacho reinterprets that classic Spanish soup by adding yogurt, Marcona almonds and fresh green herbs, which lends some textural interest. Make sure to use Spanish sherry vinegar and Marcona almonds for their distinctive rich flavor, if available.

The slightly sweet green grapes and the vibrant green European cucumber offer a pale creamy green color to the soup. I like to garnish soups with ingredients that are already in the soup; the grapes and almonds along with the green herbs offer an enticing finish to the soup here.

If you are making this up ahead, make sure to add the almonds just before serving so they don't soften. Also, season to taste after it is refrigerated.

Guests will be happily surprised with this take on gazpacho for its cool and refreshing affect as the days get hotter. I might serve this with a charcuterie platter with sliced meats and cheeses of your choice and a variety of breads for a small lunchtime gathering, or as a prelude to dinner. It is the perfect beginning for paella or any grilled fish or poultry.

### White Gazpacho (Serves 6)

2 medium garlic cloves, ends discarded  
 1 European cucumber, halved lengthwise and seeded  
 1 1/4 cup green grapes  
 2 slices white bread, crusts removed, and cut into 2 inch-pieces  
 1 1/2 cups low-fat plain Greek yogurt  
 1 1/2 cups chicken or vegetable stock  
 1/4 cup olive oil  
 2 tablespoons sherry vinegar  
 2 tablespoons chopped fresh parsley  
 1 tablespoon finely chopped fresh chives  
 1/2 cup plus 2 tablespoons roasted and salted Spanish Marcona almonds, coarsely chopped  
 Pinch of cayenne pepper  
 Salt and freshly ground white pepper



1. In a food processor, mince the garlic. Cut the cucumber in half, then chop one half into chunks and add them to the food processor, along with the 1 cup of the grapes. Process for about 20 seconds, or until pureed. Add the bread and puree again.
2. Combine the yogurt and broth in a medium bowl. Add the pureed cucumber mixture, olive oil, vinegar, 1 tablespoon each parsley and chives, and 1/2 cup of the almonds. Mix until well combined.
3. Chop the remaining half cucumber into small dice and add to the soup mixture. Add the cayenne, and salt and pepper to taste. Refrigerate until chilled, at least 4 hours.
4. To make the garnishes, cut the remaining 1/4 cup of grapes in half and transfer to a small bowl. Add the remaining 2 tablespoons of chopped almonds and toss with the grapes
5. To serve, pour the gazpacho into individual small soup bowls and garnish with the grape and almond mixture and a sprinkling of remaining parsley, and serve immediately.

**Advance preparation:** This may be made ahead through Step 3, covered and refrigerated one day ahead of serving.






