

Damage to vehicle

Police responded to the 4300 block of 65 Street after receiving a report of a vehicle with a damaged windshield and driver’s-side window. Officers attended the scene and confirmed the damage. The investigation into this incident remains ongoing.

Theft

The representative of a local retail business reported a known male suspect had stolen a large quantity of product from the business. This matter is still under investigation.

Scam

A person reported being scammed by telephone out of \$900 by someone claiming to be with a telephone provider.

Unregistered vehicle

Police conducted a traffic stop for an unregistered vehicle. The operator of the vehicle also had no insurance and was arrested on a warrant.

Outstanding warrant

Police observed and arrested a suspect with an outstanding warrant. The suspect was also charged with possession of illegal cigarettes (not marked for taxes.)

False identification

Staff at St. Mary’s Hospital reported a male in the emergency room providing inconsistent identification information. Police attended and located the individual, who then provided the officers with false identification. His true identity was later confirmed and he was found to be in possession of identity documents belonging to another person. The male was charged in relation to the offences.

Erratic driving

A representative of a local retail business reported a male subject driving erratically. Police located the subject vehicle. The operator of the vehicle was charged for not having insurance and a valid driver’ licence

Pointing firearm

Police responded to the downtown area for a report of a road rage incident. The investigation determined that a male driver had confronted another motorist and brandished a firearm. The suspect vehicle was later located, and police conducted a high-risk traffic stop. The driver and passenger were arrested, and a search of the vehicle recovered a firearm, later confirmed to be imitation, along with additional weapons. The driver was consequently charged in relation to the incident.


Unregistered and uninsured

Police conducted a stop on an unregistered vehicle. The operator and registered owner of the vehicle was charged with no registration and no insurance.

Causing concerns

A person reported a male subject causing concerns at a local bar, including punching another person causing injury. Bar staff detained the male subject until police arrived. The male subject was arrested and charged with assault causing bodily harm.





THE MORNING BITE the kitchn

I eat these Buffalo cauliflower bites straight from the pan

I'm pretty much a fan of any spicy condiment so I love Buffalo sauce, in all its tangy, buttery glory. I'm also a vegetarian — so no Buffalo wings for me. But who cares! Wings are just the gateway into Buffalo sauce; once you've joined the fan club, there are plenty of other (and arguably better) ways to enjoy it. These buffalo cauliflower bites are my latest obsession, and I guarantee they're the best on the internet. Here's how to make them.

Key Ingredients in Buffalo cauliflower bites

Cauliflower: Cut a medium head of cauliflower into large florets (about 8 cups).

Garlic powder: Season with garlic powder, coating the florets evenly.

Hot sauce: Although the brand you use is entirely up to you (Frank's, Texas Pete, Sriracha, Cholula — the list goes on), Frank's RedHot has that classic Buffalo wing flavor. It's what I use in every Buffalo sauce recipe, and it's never let me down.

I didn't invent Buffalo cauliflower — I just made it better

A quick Pinterest search will reveal there's been more than a few iterations on Buffalo cauliflower bites. Many are designed to mimic restaurant-style Buffalo chicken wings, meaning the florets are dredged in beaten egg, dipped in flour or panko, then baked or fried. Not only did I find this messy, but the bites also turned out more gummy than crisp and the cauliflower itself got lost.

So I considered my priorities. I wanted these bites to be as easy as possible (ideally just three ingredients, not counting olive oil, salt, and pepper), as healthy as possible (oven-baked rather than fried, and made with olive oil in place of butter), and as crispy as possible (crank up that oven temperature). They should be delicious as a side dish, just as great for feeding friends as an appetizer, and even better stuffed into corn tortillas for taco night.

The solution? Coating large florets in olive oil and seasoning with plenty of salt, pepper, and garlic powder (don't be shy — cauliflower itself doesn't have a ton of flavor, so a heavy hand is a must), roasting at 475 F on the lowest oven rack until beginning to crisp, tossing with the hot sauce so that every piece is coated, and returning to the oven until the sauce is warm and the veg is extra-crisp.

Buffalo Cauliflower Bites (Serves 4)

1 medium head cauliflower (about 2 pounds), cut into large florets (about 8 cups)
 4 tablespoons olive oil, divided
 2 teaspoons garlic powder
 1 teaspoon kosher salt
 1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
 1/3 cup hot sauce, such as Frank's RedHot



1. Arrange an oven rack in the lowest position and heat to 475 F. Place 2 pounds cauliflower florets on a rimmed baking sheet. Drizzle with 3 tablespoons of the olive oil and toss to combine. Sprinkle with 2 teaspoons garlic powder, 1 teaspoon kosher salt, and 1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper, and toss until thoroughly seasoned. Arrange in an even layer.

2. Roast until golden-brown and beginning to crisp, about 15 minutes. Meanwhile, whisk 1/3 cup hot sauce and remaining 1 tablespoon olive oil together in a small bowl or liquid measuring cup.

3. Remove the cauliflower from oven. Pour the hot sauce mixture over the cauliflower and use a spatula to toss until the florets are evenly coated. Return to the oven and roast until crispy, 5 to 10 minutes more. The bites are best eaten immediately.



MEET A CHEF: Tyson Wright **Resident Chef & Pitmaster at The Old Red Barn;** **Executive Chef at Strada Coffee Co. (Camrose)**

Chef Tyson Wright has been working in the food and beverage industry for 23 years! 
