United Conservatives are celebrating major accomplishments for Alberta's economy, energy future, and community supports. This week, our government helped advance the Pathways carbon capture project and oilsands growth, launched a safer regulated online gaming market, and increased support for Albertans experiencing family violence. These will help build safer and more prosperous communities in our province.

United Conservatives delivered another milestone for Alberta's energy sector this week. Our government signed a new agreement with the Government of Canada and the country's five largest oilsands producers to grow oilsands production while advancing the Pathways project. Once developed, Pathways will be the world's largest carbon capture and storage project. It's expected to store about six million tonnes of carbon dioxide every year, create up to 40,000 jobs across the country, and bring billions of dollars in investment to Alberta. This agreement supports our government's goal of doubling oil production over the next 10 to 15 years and getting more Alberta energy to global markets. This further proves that we can grow energy production and reduce emissions at the same time.

Alberta's new regulated online gaming market is now live, giving Albertans who choose to gamble online a safer, legal alternative to unregulated websites. The new market puts player safety first, requiring all regulated online gaming operators to provide responsible gambling tools such as spending limits, time limits, and gaming activity statements. Before this new market was introduced, about 70 per cent of online gambling in Alberta happened through unregulated sites – many of which offered weak player protections and little accountability. Alberta's regulated market creates a safer, more responsible environment for online gaming while holding operators to high standards.

No one experiencing family violence should be left without any options. That's why United Conservatives are investing an additional \$16 million to help shelters and local community organizations help survivors get the supports they need, no matter where they are in Alberta. This funding will support more than emergency shelter beds. It will help local organizations work together to provide crisis support, safety planning, outreach, and other services for women and children experiencing family violence in their own communities. This investment will help shelters and local support organizations provide potentially life-saving support to survivors when they need it most.

Alberta's strength comes from building opportunity while making sure families, workers, and communities have the support they need. Pathways will help create well-paying jobs, attract investment, and position Alberta as an energy superpower. A regulated online gaming market will give players safer options and stronger protections online. More funding for family violence programs will help survivors find safety and support. Together, these investments show that United Conservatives are focused on protecting what matters: you and your families.

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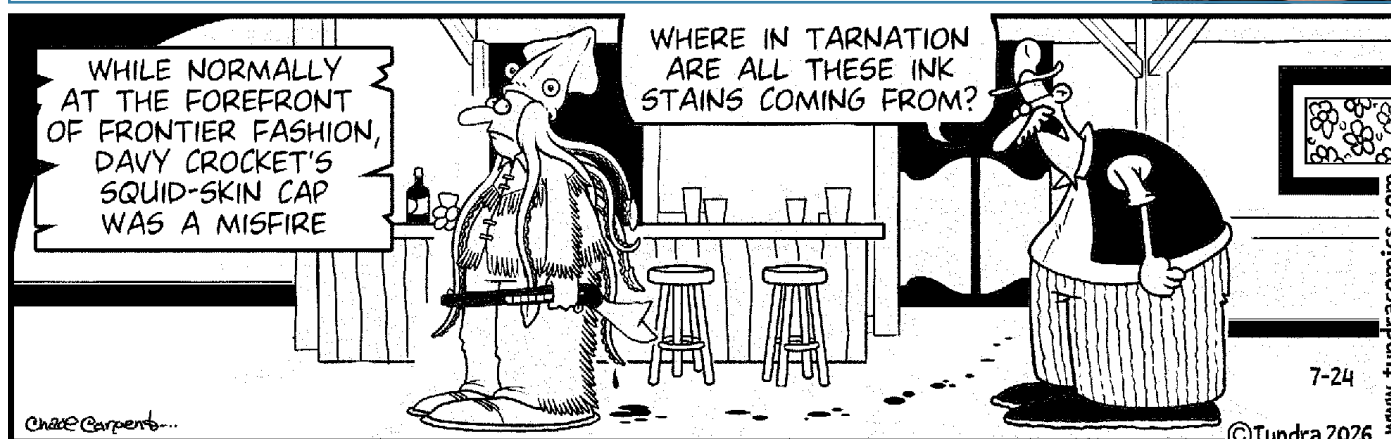

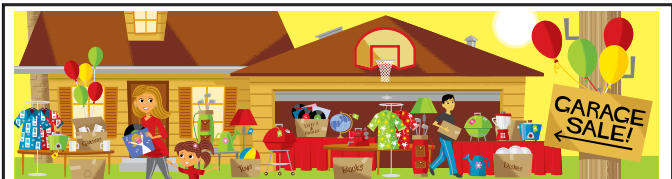

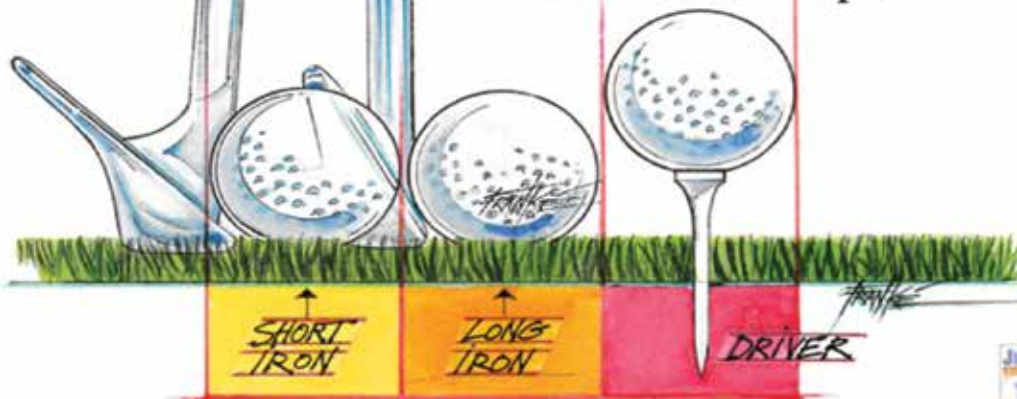

MASTER STROKES

Get Your Own Place!

Some new golfers are confused about where to position the ball in their stance. Here's a tip to find the right spot for you. Go to a soft field with an iron club. Take your normal set-up, then swing so you take a noticeable divot. Note where the divot lies in relation to your feet. For short and middle irons, play the ball **1** inch behind where the divot starts, so you make contact while the club is still descending. For long irons and fairway woods, play it one ball-width more forward, so you make contact at nearly the bottom of the swing. With a teed-up driver, move it **one** more ball-width forward, so you connect as the club is just beginning to ascend from its lowest point.

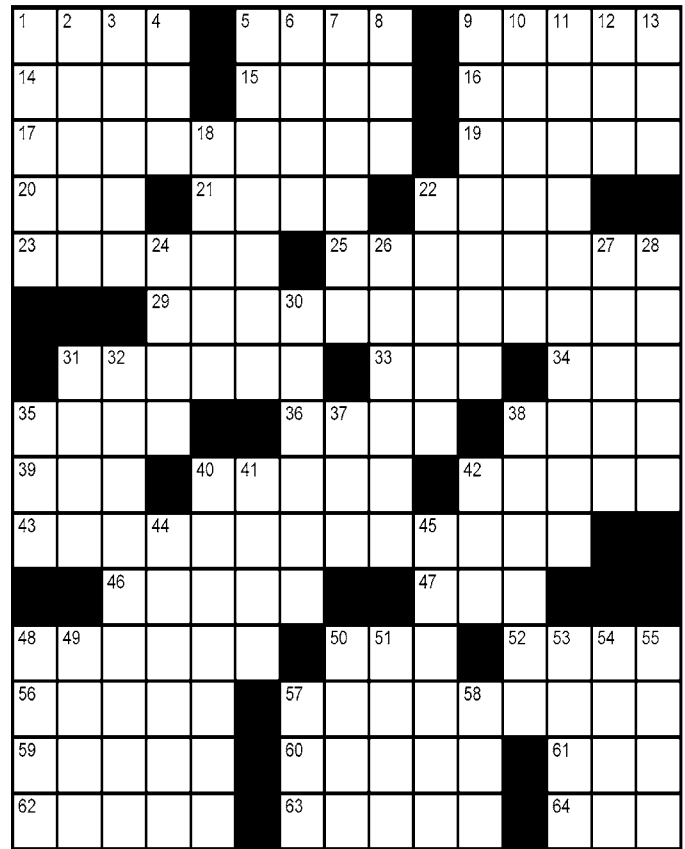

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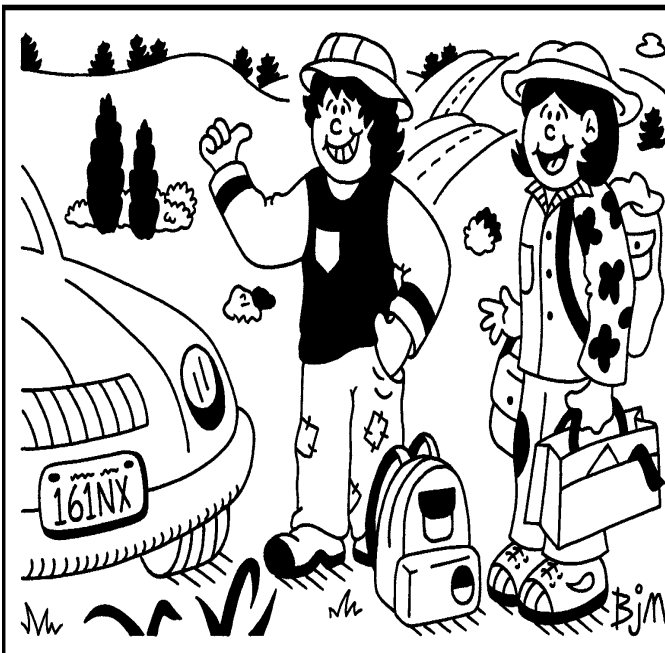

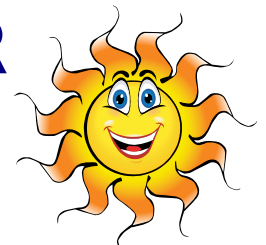

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Understanding Grief...

Grief is a normal but sometimes overwhelming *emotion*. It is a response to the loss of someone or something that we have formed relationship or a bond with. There are many dimensions to this emotion that have impacts on our physical body, our cognitive functions, social interactions, and our spirituality. It is normal to find yourself feeling numb and removed from daily life, unable to carry on with regular duties while saddled with the sense of loss. Grief is both a universal and a personal experience. Individual experiences of grief vary and are influenced by the nature of the loss.

Experts advise those grieving to realize they can't control the process and to prepare for varying stages of grief. Understanding why you're suffering can help, as can talking to others and trying to resolve issues that cause significant emotional pain.

Mourning is the expression of *grief*, occurring as a result of someone's death. It is a personal and a collective response which can vary depending on the contexts of the relationships we have.

Ceremony is a unified ritualistic event with a purpose, usually consisting of a number of human expressions such as music, spoken word, poetry, or other artistic components. The purpose of a funeral ceremony is for those who are experiencing grief to come together in a meaningful way that allows for the expression of our grief. Every ceremony is as unique as the individual whose life we are celebrating. Some ceremonies may have rich traditions that incorporate religious or spiritual elements. Other ceremonies may be very simple and only have a few components. *The important thing is that grief shared is grief diminished* and ceremony's that allow for people to mourn together can greatly support our path to acceptance.
