Police attended several collisions, no reports of injury, and dealt with two separate incidents of operator of motor vehicle having no insurance and no vehicle registration.

Notable incidents

Fraud

A person reported their bank account was compromised resulting in the loss of nearly \$3,000. The person reporting suspected an online fraud or hacking of their online banking information. A 57-year-old male was arrested after he deposited a fraudulent cheque into his bank account. He was charged with Fraud Under \$5,000 and released to appear in court.

Police remind residents to be very diligent about releasing any personal information online or over the telephone and never release information to unknown or unverified sources. Report any suspected fraud or scam activity to the police and/or online on the Government of Canada Report Cybercrime and Fraud website.

Assault

A person called 911 to report being assaulted by a known male. Police attended the area of the call and located a female victim and male suspect. The male suspect was arrested and charged with assault. The male also had a warrant for his arrest for outstanding fines.

Assault

A 911 caller reported being assaulted with a knife, by a youth known to the victim. Police attended and spoke with the caller who identified the suspect. Police located and arrested the youth who was charged with assault with a weapon.

Causing a disturbance

An employee of a local restaurant reported a male subject causing issues and refusing to leave the premises. Police attended and spoke to the male subject, who appeared agitated, but eventually left the premises.

Internal theft

The owner of a local restaurant reported an ex-employee had stolen \$8,000 from the business. This matter is still under investigation.

Resist arrest/assault police officer

A person reported a possible fight occurring between a female and male at a neighboring residence. Police attended and located the male subject, determined to be intoxicated. The female had left prior to police arrival. The 50-year-old male subject was arrested for breaching alcohol conditions, during arrest he became uncooperative, resisting arrest. The male was charged with two counts of assault on a police officer, resisting arrest and uttering threats.

Impaired driver

Police conducted a traffic stop for equipment violations and noted the operator of the vehicle to be under the influence of alcohol. The operator failed the original roadside screening device test and was transported to Camrose Police Service where he provided samples of 290mg % and 270mg%. The 28-year-old male was charged and released on provincial driving sanctions.



A classic pesto vinaigrette brightens up this chicken dinner

Chicken paillards are the perfect weeknight entree since they take just a few minutes to pound and even less time to cook. They are traditionally served with a splash of lemon or a simple uncomplicated sauce.

To flatten the chicken breasts, place them on a cutting board between plastic wrap or wax paper and pound with the smooth side of a meat pounder, a rolling pin or even the bottom of a heavy skillet or saucepan. I find the easiest way to create an even thickness is to pound from the thickest part at the center to the outer edges. The key to keeping these pounded chicken cutlets moist is quick cooking on high heat to sear the outside while briefly cooking the interior. It's best to use a heavy non-stick ridged grill pan or skillet to sauté them. A grill pan will leave dark caramelized grill marks; a sauté pan will leave an even browned exterior and allows for making a quick deglazed sauce.

This classic pesto blend here is a lovely combination of toasted pine nuts, assertive basil leaves and Italian parsley that adds just the right flavor to the thin cutlets. (This pesto is also great on fish or swirled into hot pasta.)

Chicken Paillard with Pesto Vinaigrette (Serve 4 to 6)

For the vinaigrette:

1/3 cup favorite vinaigrette
 1 tablespoon Pesto (see below)

For the chicken:

6 (6) ounce chicken breast halves, skinned
 Juice of 1 lemon
 1/4 cup Basil Pesto (see below)
 Salt and freshly ground black pepper



1. Combine the vinaigrette and pesto in a small bowl and mix until blended. Reserve.
2. Place each chicken breast half between two pieces of plastic wrap, and use the smooth side of a mallet or the bottom of a saucepan to evenly pound them 1/4-inch thick.
3. Place the paillards on a sheet pan and squeeze the lemon juice over them on both sides. Spread a thin layer of pesto on each side of each paillard.
4. Heat a non-stick skillet or grill pan on medium-high heat and spray with olive oil. When the skillet is hot saute the paillards in batches, about 2 to 3 minutes per side.
5. Place on serving plates and spoon over some vinaigrette. Serve immediately.

Basil Pesto (Makes about 1 1/4 cups)

1/2 cup pinenuts
 3 medium garlic cloves
 1 1/2 cups fresh Italian parsley leaves, firmly packed, (about 1 medium bunch)
 1 cup fresh basil leaves
 Zest of 1 lemon
 1/2 cup olive oil
 Freshly ground black pepper
 1/2 cup freshly grated Parmesan cheese

1. Preheat the oven to 350 F. Place the nuts on a baking sheet and toast them for about 5 minutes or until lightly browned and fragrant. Watch carefully. Reserve.
2. While the motor is running, add the garlic cloves to a food processor fitted with the metal blade. Process until pureed. Add herbs and lemon zest and process until finely chopped. Add reserved toasted nuts and finely chop.
3. With blades turning, slowly pour in the olive oil in a fine stream. Scrape down the sides of the bowl to blend the ingredients. Add pepper. Just before serving, add the cheese and process until well blended.
4. Taste for seasoning Store and remaining pesto in an airtight container in the refrigerator for up to one week.




