

MEET A CHEF: KRISTY OLSEN Culinary Director, Brew & Bloom (Edmonton)

Kristy Olsen is the Chef Owner of Eden Restaurant 186, a private dining experience located in a restored historic home in Southern Alberta. With over 27 years in the hospitality industry, her career spans both front-of-house leadership and culinary excellence.

Raised just outside of Raymond, Alberta, Kristy's connection to food began with her family and the land. Her grandfather, Vern Olsen, led the culinary department at Lethbridge College for decades and helped shape generations of chefs across the region. His influence instilled in her a deep respect for craft, mentorship, and community.

Kristy earned both her Cook and Baking Red Seal certifications and currently serves as President of the Lethbridge Branch of the Culinary Federation, as well as National Recruitment Chair. She is also actively involved in apprenticeship development, helping guide the next generation of culinary professionals.

At Eden Restaurant 186, Kristy curates intimate dining experiences rooted in seasonality and Alberta-grown ingredients. Each menu is tailored to guests and built around relationships with local farmers, ranchers, and producers.

Her work is driven by a belief that food is more than nourishment — it is a way to gather, reconnect, and celebrate place. Through Eden and her mentorship roles, Kristy continues to champion Alberta's culinary identity and the people who help grow it.

What made you want to be a chef?

"Food was always tied to people in my life — family dinners, time spent on my grandparents' farm, and watching how meals brought people together. As I grew, I realized the kitchen was a place where craft and care could live side by side. Becoming a chef allowed me to create experiences that connect people, honour where we come from, and pass knowledge forward."

Why do you use Alberta ingredients in your kitchen?

"Using Alberta ingredients is a natural extension of who I am and where I was raised. I know the farmers, ranchers, and producers behind the food. Cooking with their ingredients allows me to tell the story of our region through each menu — showcasing not only quality, but community."

What is your favourite Alberta ingredient to use?

"Root vegetables — especially potatoes, beets, and carrots. Growing up, my family always had a garden, and those ingredients were constants on our table. Many dinners included freshly dug up vegetables simply prepared with butter and salt, alongside warm homemade buns and a pot of soup that would simmer throughout the day for anyone who needed it. That simplicity shaped my understanding of how powerful humble ingredients can be. Today, I'm still drawn to those same roots — using them to create dishes that honour both our landscape and the quiet comfort of the meals I grew up with."

What dish should guests be sure to try on your menu?

"At Eden, there isn't one signature dish to point to. The menu changes almost daily, guided by what's in season and what feels inspiring in the moment. The experience is less about choosing a specific plate and more about trusting the process — sitting down to a family-style meal shaped by Alberta ingredients and the creativity they spark that day."

Alberta on the Plate showcases the incredible bounty that is grown and produced across our beautiful province. Throughout the year, we celebrate and share the Alberta food story by introducing you to the people and businesses that grow, raise, create, and support the agri-food industry in Alberta. Albertans are known for stepping up when times are tough, and Budget 2026 reflects that same spirit. United Conservatives have returned to the Legislature for the spring session with a budget built around a clear theme of focusing on what matters, responding to global uncertainty, rising costs, and rapid population growth with a steady, practical plan. It protects the services Albertans rely on, supports workers and families, and keeps our province strong through challenging economic conditions – including Camrose and surrounding communities.

Budget 2026 invests in what matters most, including major improvements to healthcare. It expands capacity with more hospital beds, more healthcare professionals, and better access to services. The budget makes a record \$7.7 billion investment in physicians – a 22 per cent increase – to support recruitment, training, and compensation, including \$7.3 billion for physician services and \$450 million for recruitment and education. These investments strengthen primary care, support specialists and surgeons, and help manage growing patient needs in communities large and small, including those served by healthcare teams in the Camrose area. Additional funding in surgical capacity, mental health and addiction care, continuing care, and diagnostic technology further improves access and supports frontline teams.

In education, our government is making the largest education investment in Alberta's history to respond to rapid growth and rising classroom complexity. It provides \$10.8 billion in operating funding – about \$54 million per day – including support to hire 1,600 teachers and 800 support staff next year. Over three years, funding will grow to \$11.5 billion, supporting more than 5,000 new staff. The budget also invests \$1.8 billion for students with specialized learning needs, \$560 million for enrolment growth, and \$355 million to manage class size and complexity. Additional supports include early literacy and numeracy funding, student transportation, and curriculum renewal to help classrooms keep pace with Alberta's fast growing student population.

To keep Alberta's economy moving, Budget 2026 invests in skills training, workforce development, infrastructure, and industries that create long term opportunity. Funding supports entrepreneurs, innovation, regional economic development, and growth in key sectors. A three year, \$28.3 billion capital plan strengthens roads, transit, hospitals, post secondary facilities, and other critical infrastructure, supporting tens of thousands of jobs across the province.

Even as Alberta projects a \$9.4 billion deficit – driven largely by global volatility and rapid population growth – the province remains in the strongest fiscal position in Canada. Alberta continues to have the lowest overall tax burden, the strongest GDP per capita, and some of the highest weekly earnings in the country. The budget takes a disciplined, responsible approach by focusing on priorities and controlling costs at a time when families, farms, and businesses in regions like Camrose are also navigating economic pressure.

Budget 2026 also continues Alberta's long term commitment to the Alberta Heritage Savings Trust Fund. United Conservatives have been steadily paying into the fund and maintaining a plan to grow it to \$250 billion by 2050. The fund is expected to reach about \$34 billion by the end of 2026, up from \$31.5 billion the year before. By protecting and growing this fund, Alberta is setting aside wealth today so future generations – including young people growing up in Camrose and across rural Alberta – can benefit from long term financial stability.

Budget 2026 is designed to help Alberta weather today's challenges while building a stronger future. By staying focused on what matters – better healthcare, stronger schools, good jobs, and the infrastructure that keeps communities growing – United Conservatives are taking steady, responsible steps forward. St. Patrick's Day comfort food, lightened up

Corned beef is brisket that has been pickled in spices for days, but it is often high in sodium. To help control the salt level, we use pickling spice — a blend featuring mustard seed, coriander and black pepper — to achieve a similar flavor. A medley of cabbage, potatoes and carrots rounds out the dish for a hearty, cozy meal.

Baked Corned Beef & Cabbage (Serves 8)

Active Time: 15 minutes

Total Time: 2 hours and 45 minutes

- 1 (2 1/2 pound) boneless beef shoulder pot roast, trimmed
- 1 tablespoon neutral oil, such as canola or avocado
- 2 tablespoons pickling spice, ground
- 1 3/4 teaspoons salt
- 1 1/2 pounds Savoy or green cabbage (about 1/2 medium head), cored and cut into 2 1/2-inch hunks
- 1 1/2 pounds baby red potatoes, scrubbed and halved
- 1 pound carrots, scrubbed and cut into 2-inch pieces
- 1 cup unsalted beef stock
- 1 1/2 tablespoons stone-ground Dijon mustard



1. Preheat oven to 325 F. Place beef on a large sheet of heavy-duty foil. Rub evenly with oil. Sprinkle evenly with pickling spice and salt. Wrap the foil completely around the beef; place in a large roasting pan. Bake for 1 hour.

2. Remove the pan from the oven; carefully remove the foil, allowing the drippings to fall into the pan. Nestle cabbage, potatoes and carrots in the pan around and under the beef. Drizzle stock over the vegetables. Cover the pan with foil. Return to the oven; bake until the vegetables are tender and an instant-read thermometer inserted in the thickest portion of the beef registers 200 F, about 1 hour.

3. Remove from the oven; carefully transfer the beef to a cutting board. Let stand for 10 minutes. Slice the beef thinly; serve with the vegetables and mustard. Spoon the pan drippings over the vegetables and meat, if desired.






