PROJECT CRUSH

The Camrose Police Service Major Crimes Unit has concluded an ongoing drug investigation this month, which resulted in 22 drug trafficking related charges, 11 possession for the purposes of trafficking charges, and 2 proceeds of crime charges. Members of the Camrose Police Service worked over the last 8 months focusing on the activities of drug suppliers who were distributing large amounts of cocaine, methamphetamine, and fentanyl into the City of Camrose.

As a result of the investigation the following people have been charged:

Caroline BOWIE, 57, was charged with five counts of trafficking, one count of possession for the purposes of trafficking, possession of a controlled substance, and proceeds of crime. BOWIE has since pled guilty to her charges and received a conditional sentence order.

Stefan WEIMER, 36, was charged with two counts of trafficking.

Terrance BERGSETH, 28, was charged with three counts of trafficking and proceeds of crime.

Kendall DELANEY, 25, was charged with five counts of trafficking, one count of possession for the purposes of trafficking and two counts of breaching a court order.

Jessie WEINRICH, 19, was charged with three counts of trafficking.

Melanie MYO, 33, was charged with one count of trafficking.

Carmen BROWN, 45, was charged with three counts of possession for the purposes of trafficking and

two counts of possession of a controlled substance. BROWN has since pled guilty to her charges and received a conditional sentence order.

Kimberley MCLEAN, 37, was charged with two counts of possession for the purposes of trafficking and two counts of trafficking.

Steven IRVINE, 31, was charged with two counts of possession for the purposes of trafficking.

David OTTON, 58, was charged with two counts of possession for the purposes of trafficking, one count of possession of illicit cannabis, and proceeds of crime.

Drug trafficking brings violence, property crime, addiction and health consequences to our community. The Camrose Police Service along with its partners are committed to disrupt the city's drug trade.







We are currently in Stage 2 of our 4-stage water shortage response plan. The following MANDATORY water restrictions are in place:

- Lawns may only be watered between 6AM to 9AM and 7PM to 11PM.
 - Odd-numbered houses may water only on odd-numbered days.
 - Even-numbered houses may water only on even-numbered days.
- Flowerbeds, vegetable gardens and newly-laid sod may be watered at any time by hand, provided that the water used has been drawn from a rain barrel, from a watering can, or a hose with a nozzle fitted with a trigger shut-off to restrict water flow.
- Vehicles can only be washed with bucket and hand held hose or at a commercial car wash. Pressure washers are not allowed to wash vehicles.
- Additional water restrictions can be found under Stage 2 of the Water Shortage Response Plan or Stage 2 of the Water Conservation / Water Use Policy.

Any violation of these restrictions can result in fines.

MEET A PRODUCER Cheri Day, Egg Farmer in Calmar, AB

How long have you been an egg farmer?

We have free run/free range layers over the last 12 years on a hobby size scale, however, we have stepped into the commercial size egg farming industry this past summer.

If you are a multi-generational farm, how many generations has your family/colony been in egg farming?

My extended family has been in the cattle, sheep and grain industry for many generations, however, my family is a first generation egg farmer.

Why did you first get into egg farming?

It seemed like a natural way to go in the progression of our farm. As a Registered Nurse, I have been very conscious of the food that I feed my family. We have been active in raising our own meat and like knowing where our food comes from and how it been raised. We raise our own beef, pork and dairy for our family and the Egg Farmers of Alberta industry were looking for new entrants into the industry. I was interested and explored the opportunity to provide healthy eggs for not only our family and friends but to our community as well.

What does being an egg farmer mean to you?

To me, being an egg farmer means providing a safe, happy and healthy environment for our animals and in return, they provide healthy and nutritious eggs.

What do you enjoy most about being an egg farmer?

I enjoy being amongst the bird and making sure that they are healthy and happy.

What type of farm do you have (ie: hen housing system)?

We have a free-run, aviary multi-tiered system for the hens to perch, eat, drink, and lay their eggs in.

How does it make you feel to know you provide your fellow Albertans with fresh, nutritious and delicious, locally produced eggs? I am excited and proud to be apart of providing fresh, healthy and nutritious eggs for our family, community and fellow Albertans.

If there is one thing you would like people to know about egg farming and/or egg farmers, what would it be? From what I have seen, egg farmers take their responsibility of caring for their birds and providing quality, nutritious eggs seriously.

Alberta on the Plate showcases the incredible bounty that is grown and produced across our beautiful province. Throughout the year, we celebrate and share the Alberta food story by introducing you to the people and businesses that grow, raise, create, and support the agri-food industry in Alberta. 





This 160-year-old Italian chicken recipe is always in my dinner rotation

When I'm looking for a dinner that is a step up from chicken nuggets but still appeals to eaters of all ages, chicken Milanese is just the ticket. Milanese (or milanesa) refers to breading and frying thin cutlets of meat, and you've probably heard of similar dishes like veal Milanese, or Wiener schnitzel from Austria. Chicken Milanese may sound fancy, but it's really just thin chicken breast cutlets prepared in the same way so that it's crispy on the outside and juicy on the inside.

It's quite a versatile main dish, requiring nothing more than a simple green salad and some lemon to turn it into a complete dinner. You can even take it a step further and bake it with marinara sauce and mozzarella cheese for a take on classic chicken Parmesan. This recipe makes eight cutlets, which means there's plenty for dinner. Plus, leftovers are great for throwing in a salad or sandwich for a quick and hearty meal.

Why you'll love it

You're guaranteed perfectly crunchy and juicy chicken. Starting with thinly pounded chicken means that it fries up quickly, staying juicy inside and super crispy on the outside.

It pairs well with other dishes. Chicken Milanese is versatile; serve it with a simple salad, next to rice pilaf, or with roasted vegetables.

Key ingredients in Chicken Milanese

Chicken breast. You'll need four boneless, skinless chicken breasts. Try to get ones that are all about the same size (about 8 ounces or medium size is great here).

Breadcrumbs. Plain dry, fine breadcrumbs fry up deliciously crispy in Milanese. Don't use the seasoned or Italian-flavored breadcrumbs.

Garlic and onion powders. These two spices add a nice background flavor to the chicken.

Vegetable oil. Fry with regular vegetable or canola oil because they have a neutral flavor.

Helpful swaps

Want to do less pounding? Just purchase 2 pounds chicken cutlets or thin-cut chicken breasts instead. These thinner pieces of chicken don't require butterflying and just need a quick pound to get them to the right thickness since they're already thinner.

Panko breadcrumbs can be used in place of the fine bread crumbs, but you will need to increase the amount to 2 cups. Squeeze the panko with your hands to get the crumbs a bit smaller.

Any neutral flavored, high smoke point oil (like safflower or grapeseed oil) can be used in place of the vegetable oil.

Chicken Milanese (Serves 4 to 8)

- 1 medium lemon
- 4 medium boneless, skinless chicken breasts (2 to 2 1/2 pounds total)
- 2 teaspoons kosher salt, divided, plus more for sprinkling






1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

1/2 cup all-purpose flour

3 large eggs

- 1 1/2 cups plain, fine breadcrumbs
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon onion powder
- 1 3/4 cups canola oil or vegetable oil





- 2. Cut four boneless, skinless chicken breasts in half horizontally (also known as butterflying) to get eight pieces total. Pound one piece of chicken at a time: Place between two sheets of plastic wrap or in a large zip-top bag. Use the flat side of a meat mallet or the bottom of a small heavy-bottomed skillet to pound until about 1/4-inch thick.
- 3. Place the chicken on a baking sheet and season all over with 1 1/2 teaspoons of the kosher salt and 1/2 teaspoon black pepper.
- 4. Place 1/2 cup all-purpose flour on a large plate. Beat three large eggs in a wide, shallow bowl with a fork until no streaks of egg white remain. Place 1 1/2 cups plain breadcrumbs, 1 teaspoon garlic powder, 1 teaspoon onion powder, and the remaining 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt in a second wide, shallow bowl, and stir to combine.
- 5. Working with one piece of chicken at a time, dredge in the flour mixture, then the eggs, and finally the breadcrumb mixture, gently pressing the breadcrumbs into the chicken so they stick. Return to the baking sheet in an even layer (they can overlap slightly).
- 6. Heat 1 3/4 cups canola oil in a large (12-inch) cast-iron or other heavy-bottomed frying pan over medium-high heat until shimmering (a pinch of breadcrumbs dropped into the oil should sizzle immediately). Meanwhile, fit a second baking sheet with a wire rack or line with paper towels.
- 7. Working in batches of two, carefully add the chicken to the hot oil and fry until cooked through and golden-brown, 2 to 3 minutes per side. Transfer to the rack or paper towels and sprinkle lightly with kosher salt. Serve with the lemon wedges.

Recipe notes

Make ahead: Butterfly and pound the chicken up to two days ahead and refrigerate in an airtight container. The breadcrumb mixture can be made up to one week ahead and stored in an airtight container at room temperature.

Storage: Leftovers can be refrigerated in an airtight container for up to three days. Reheat in a low oven until warmed through and crisp.




