9 easy hacks to instantly upgrade fried eggs

A simple fried egg cooked in melted butter or a neutral oil is a classic for a reason: It adds crispy-edged oomph without interrupting the flavor of whatever's already on the plate. While we love a good basic egg for its satisfying familiarity, why not expand your horizons? We now live in a time when there are endless ingredients you can use to fry your eggs to infuse them with different flavors, personality, and crispiness every time. The best part of getting creative with how you make fried eggs? It all hinges on pantry and fridge ingredients you likely already have in the kitchen. From fiery condiment additions to garlic and even crumbly cheese, here are 11 ways to instantly elevate your fried eggs for toast, rice bowls, noodles, and so much more.

1. Chili Crisp Fried Eggs

Savory, crispy, and slightly spicy, these fried eggs are mesmerizing to watch as they cook in the bright-red chili crisp oil. Adding toasted sesame oil brings a subtle, delicious nutty flavor that makes the fried eggs taste incredible.

2. Harissa Fried Eggs

Harissa paste, an aromatic North African chile paste blended with peppers, citrus, cumin, coriander, and caraway, takes your fried eggs to an 11.

3. Sesame Fried Eggs

The simple twist of adding sesame oil and sesame seeds to fried eggs stopped us in our tracks.

4. Spicy, Cheesy Buffalo Fried Eggs

Forget dousing your fried egg in hot sauce once it's been cooked — instead, try frying your egg in Buffalo sauce and thank us later. To a hot pan, add a tablespoon or two of Buffalo sauce to make a circular nest. Immediately crack in your eggs, followed by a sprinkling of cheese around the whites.

5. Feta Fried Eggs

This fried egg hack comes together in about five minutes, and you end up with a reliably quick breakfast that is a nice mixture of crispy, creamy textures and well-balanced salty, spicy flavors. When cooking, stick to the lower end of the heat scale so that you can achieve a proper crisp, rather than unwanted char.

6. Pickle Juice Fried Egg

7. Fried Garlic Fried Egg

Cooking fried eggs with thinly sliced garlic is only a tiny bit harder than cooking your run-of-the-mill fried eggs in a neutral cooking fat. If you can concentrate for six minutes while you focus on nothing but garlic and eggs, we recommend you give this one a try.

8. Butter-Basted Eggs

Basting an egg in butter results in a set white, a runny yolk, and plenty of delicious brown butter to serve it with.

9. Crispy Fried Eggs with Yogurt, Greens, and Smoked Herb Butter





Understanding Grief...

Grief is a normal but sometimes overwhelming *emotion*. It is a response to the loss of someone or something that we have formed relationship or a bond with. There are many dimensions to this emotion that have impacts on our physical body, our cognitive functions, social interactions, and our spirituality. It is normal to find yourself feeling numb and removed from daily life, unable to carry on with regular duties while saddled with the sense of loss. Grief is both a universal and a personal experience. Individual experiences of grief vary and are influenced by the nature of the loss.

Experts advise those grieving to realize they can't control the process and to prepare for varying stages of grief. Understanding why you're suffering can help, as can talking to others and trying to resolve issues that cause significant emotional pain.

Mourning is the expression of *grief*, occurring as a result of someone's death. It is a personal and a collective response which can vary depending on the contexts of the relationships we have.

Ceremony is a unified ritualistic event with a purpose, usually consisting of a number of human expressions such as music, spoken word, poetry, or other artistic components. The purpose of a funeral ceremony is for those who are experiencing grief to come together in a meaningful way that allows for the expression of our grief. Every ceremony is as unique as the individual whose life we are celebrating. Some ceremonies may have rich traditions that incorporate religious or spiritual elements. Other ceremonies may be very simple and only have a few components. *The important thing is that grief shared is grief diminished* and ceremony's that allow for people to mourn together can greatly support our path to acceptance.
