





#### This Mexican cocktail is a million times better than an espresso martini

I have fond memories of sipping café de olla, a traditional Mexican coffee brewed with warm spices, when I was growing up. It always felt like a hug in a mug. This café de olla martini takes that nostalgic flavor and transforms it into a sophisticated cocktail — it's the perfect combination of childhood memories and adult indulgence. Café de olla is traditionally made with pilloncillo (an unrefined Mexican cane sugar sold in coneshaped blocks), cinnamon, and sometimes star anise or cloves — it's a fragrant, sweet-spiced coffee that warms both the body and soul. In this cocktail, I wanted those spices to shine; the cinnamon, piloncillo, and subtle hints of star anise wrap around the espresso and rum to evoke the cozy feeling of a chilly fall afternoon. Although it's a cocktail that can be enjoyed year-round, it's especially great when the cooler months arrive and fall approaches. The comforting, inviting aromas of warm spices and coffee fill the room and instantly draw people in. Each sip is a delightful play of sweet, bitter, and spiced notes, so the cocktail is layered and satisfying.

#### Key ingredients in café de olla martini

Spiced rum: Adds warmth, depth, and subtle spice notes that complement the coffee flavors.

Espresso: Provides a rich, bold coffee backbone with a smooth, slightly bitter balance.

Café de olla syrup: Brings sweetness, aromatics, and a caramel-like richness that ties the cocktail together.

#### Café de Olla Martini (Serves 1)

#### For the syrup (makes about 3/4 cup):

1 cup water

2 ounces pilloncillo or panela, or 1/3 cup packed dark brown sugar

2 (about 3-inch) cinnamon sticks

1 whole star anise

#### For each cocktail:

1 1/2 ounces spiced rum

1 ounce room-temperature brewed espresso

1 ounce vodka

3/4 ounce café de olla syrup (recipe above)

1/2 ounce high-quality coffee liqueur, such as Patron XO Café

Ice

Ground cinnamon, for garnish (optional)

#### Make the syrup:

- 1. Place 1 cup water, 2 ounces pilloncillo (if it's shaped in a larger cylinder, cut into smaller pieces with a serrated knife first), 2 (about 3-inch) cinnamon sticks, and 1 whole star anise in a small saucepan. Bring to a boil over medium heat, stirring occasionally until the pilloncillo is dissolved. Reduce the heat to medium-low and simmer until the syrup is caramel-colored and reduced to 3/4 cup, 4 to 5 minutes.
- 2. Turn off heat. Let cool until warm to touch, about 30 minutes. Remove and discard the cinnamon sticks and star anise. If not using immediately, refrigerate in an airtight container for up to 10 days.

#### For each cocktail:

- 1. Place a martini glass in the freezer or refrigerator to chill for at least 5 minutes.
- 2. Place 1 1/2 ounces spiced rum, 1 ounce room temperature brewed espresso, 1 ounce vodka, 3/4 ounce café de olla syrup, and 1/2 ounce coffee liqueur in a cocktail shaker. Add enough ice to fill the shaker halfway. Seal the shaker and shake until the outside of the shaker is frothy, about 30 seconds.
- 3. Pour through a strainer into the glass. Lightly sprinkle with ground cinnamon if desired.

# **MLA Update**

Every parent knows how much a stable, reliable routine matters for their kids. The teachers' strike brought uncertainty into homes across our province. Parents were juggling schedules, students missed out on valuable learning time, and families were caught in a situation that no one wanted to see drag on.

This disruption had gone on far too long, families needed solutions, and students needed to get back to school. That's why United Conservatives introduced and passed Bill 2, the Back to School Act. This targeted legislation ends the strike, restores stability in the education system, and ensures students return to the classroom as guickly as possible.

The decision to use the notwithstanding clause wasn't one that we took lightly. But when thousands of students are missing school and parents are facing weeks of uncertainty, we had to act in the public interest.

The Back to School Act puts students first and respects the vital role of teachers. It establishes fair and reasonable terms for a new teacher collective agreement, including a 12 per cent salary increase over four years, additional market adjustments of up to 17 per cent for most teachers, and funding to hire 3,000 new teachers and 1,500 educational assistants. That means smaller class sizes and more help for kids who need it.

We also understand that teachers are facing greater challenges than ever before. Alberta's classrooms are more complex, with many students requiring extra help and more incidents of classroom aggression. That's why we created the Class Size and Complexity Task Force to find real solutions, update special-education standards, and collect better classroom data to guide funding decisions.

Our commitment to Alberta families extends beyond just ending the strike. Budget 2025 invests \$8.6 billion to build and modernize 130 schools across the province, ensuring every child learns in a safe, modern environment close to home. And for families who faced extra costs during the strike, United Conservatives launched the Parent Payment Program, providing \$30 per day per student and \$60 per day for students with disabilities, to help cover child-care and other costs incurred during the strike.

In Camrose, we are very fortunate to have the newly built St. Carlo Acutis Catholic High School which was completed and opened this school year. This new building has alleviated the overcrowding in the Camrose Constituency Catholic System. The Battle River School Division made the difficult decision to close three schools, allowing space and an opportunity for the Holden Rural Academy to open and thrive. The school reached enrollment of over 100 students.

Now that the Back to School Act is law, Alberta's students are back where they belong in their class-rooms, surrounded by friends, learning, laughing, and returning to their routines. As we move forward, United Conservatives remain focused on strengthening education, supporting teachers, and putting the success of students at the heart of every decision we make.


