



The Trailblazer: Paula Cole

Paula Cole is far more than the voice behind radio anthems like “Where Have All the Cowboys Gone?” and “I Don’t Want to Wait.” While her beloved hits remain staples on playlists worldwide, Cole’s legacy is defined by her uncompromising artistry and her role as a boundary-pushing feminist trailblazer.

A truth-teller, provocateur, and brilliant autobiographical writer, Cole became the first woman to be nominated for a Grammy for “Producer of the Year” in her own right—an achievement that speaks to her creative command. A Grammy winner for Best New Artist, she has always used her music as a vehicle for personal honesty and social change. In recent years, she has continued to explore new territory, honoring her love for jazz and folk standards while weaving powerful social statements into her deeply emotional songs. Her latest album, *Lo*, is a poignant collection that navigates the process of trusting again after life’s indelible blows, offering listeners a window into her soul and a testament to her ever-evolving craft.
