**Grandparent/parent scam....Just hang up** Camrose Police Service would like to warn residents of the Grandparent/Parent Scam that has been recently circulating.

Police have received several reports from residents who have received a telephone call from someone using the grandchild or other family member scam to scam them out of their hard earned money.

The scammer will contact the victim by telephone (often a landline and often in the evening) posing as a lawyer or police officer, grandchild or other family member, indicating that they (grandchild or family member) are in some kind of trouble, in jail and need cash for bail.

In some instances the scammer will allow the victim to speak with the alleged loved one or actually impersonate the loved one by using a device to change their voice to replicate that of a loved one's voice. They may even ask if the victim knows who is calling, prompting the victim to divulge the name of a loved one, then use that name to complete the scam.

The scammer indicates that it is urgent, pressuring the victim into providing payment quickly by providing the victim with directions on how to pay, which may include a requested email money transfer or a pickup of the cash payment by a person the scammer indicates is a bail bondsman.

#### This is a scam.

Police, lawyers and court officials will never request an electronic money transfer or send someone to a place of residence for cash payment. Hang up from the phone call and contact Camrose Police at 780-672-4444 (complaints line). 

We are currently in Stage 1 of our 4-stage water shortage response plan. The following MANDATORY water restrictions are in place:

- Lawns may only be watered between 6AM to 9AM and 7PM to 11PM.
  - Odd-numbered houses may water only on odd-numbered days.
  - Even-numbered houses may water only on even-numbered days.
- Only hand watering with a watering can or hose with trigger nozzle is allowed for flower and vegetable gardens.
- Sprinklers and water toys may be used for recreational purposes by children as long as children are actively playing, including a pool with a capacity not more than 1,000 litres.
- Decorative outdoor water features must be turned off.
   Stage 1 includes exemptions for newly laid sod.

Any violation of these restrictions can result in fines.



#### I guarantee my perfect tomato sauce is the easiest one you've ever made

There are any number of different sauces you can top your pasta with. You can go cheesy or meaty, or herby, to name a few. The one sauce that stands above the others and the undisputed pasta sauce classic is tomato sauce.

You can make great tomato sauce with tinned tomatoes. You can also get top-notch jarred sauce at the grocery store, but sauce made with fresh tomatoes is a special treat that is best left for peak-of-the-season summer produce. At least, that's what I thought until I discovered the simple shortcut for the easiest fresh tomato sauce — the oven. This sauce is the epitome of low-effort high-reward cooking. It's wildly easy to make. No need to blanch tomatoes and peel their skins before even getting to the sauce-making. Just toss tomatoes, onions, garlic, and herbs on a sheet pan with some olive oil, roast, and blend. It's been my go-to sauce for years now, and once you try it, I bet it will be yours, too.

#### Key ingredients in sheet pan tomato sauce

Plum tomatoes. Plum tomatoes have a concentrated tomato flavor, thin skins, few seeds, and low water content which makes them ideal for turning into sauce. Don't be tempted to substitute large slicing or beefsteak tomatoes here, since their thicker skins won't break down as well when the sauce is puréed.

Onions and garlic. These classic aromatics add even more flavor to the sauce when roasted.

Thyme. Fresh thyme roasts in the oven with the rest of the produce, infusing the tomatoes, onions, and garlic with flavor. The leaves are then puréed into the sauce.

Olive oil. Everything is tossed in olive oil before going into the oven, which helps with browning as well as bringing a rich flavor to the sauce. This sauce is very simple, so choose an olive oil with a good flavor (there are great options at the grocery store!)

Basil. Fresh basil finishes the sauce with a bright, herby flavor.

#### **Sheet Pan Tomato Sauce (Makes 3 cups; serves 4)**

- 1 1/2 pounds medium plum tomatoes (about 7), halved lengthwise
- 5 cloves garlic, peeled
- 1 medium yellow onion, peeled and quartered
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 teaspoon kosher salt
- 3 to 4 sprigs fresh thyme
- 1/3 cup fresh basil leaves (about 2 sprigs)
- 1. Heat the oven to 400 F.
- 2. Place 1 1/2 pounds halved medium plum tomatoes, 5 peeled garlic cloves, and 1 quartered yellow onion on a rimmed baking sheet. Drizzle with 2 tablespoons olive oil and sprinkle with 1 teaspoon kosher salt. Toss with your hands until the vegetables are coated in oil. Arrange into a single layer. Top with three to four fresh thyme sprigs.
- 3. Roast until the vegetables are browned in spots, 25 to 30 minutes.
- 4. Pick the thyme leaves from the stems and add to a blender or food processor; discard the stems. Transfer the vegetables and any juices on the baking sheet to the blender. Add 1/3 cup fresh basil leaves. Process until smooth.






