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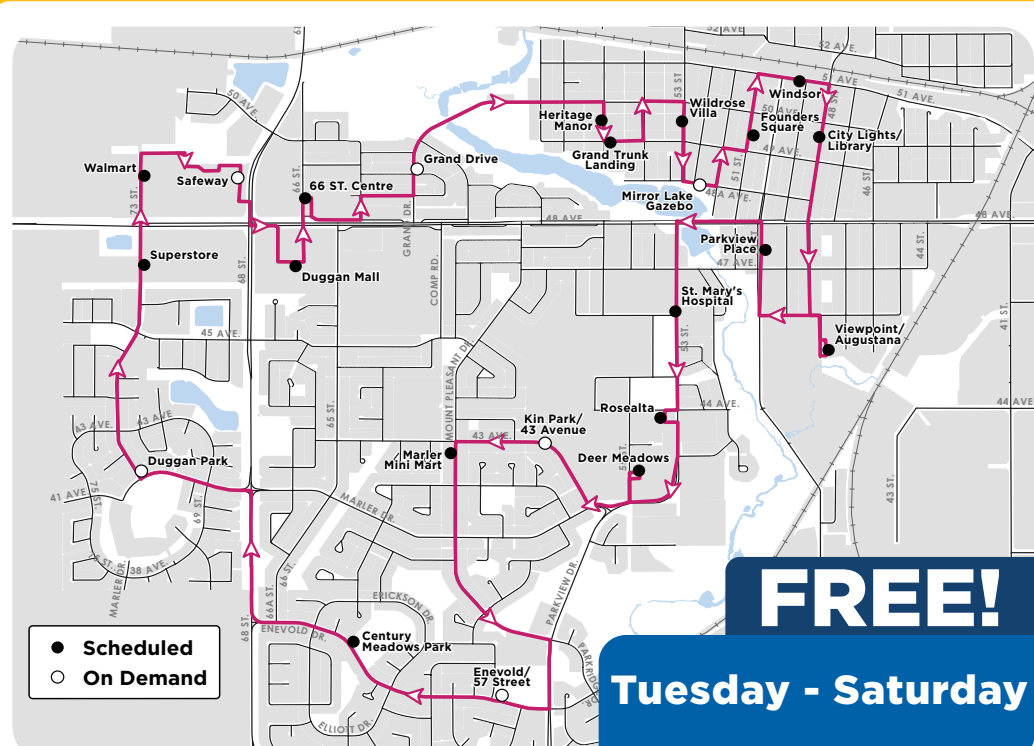

On their 25th wedding anniversary, a husband took his wife out to dinner. Their teenage daughters said they'd have dessert waiting for them when they returned.

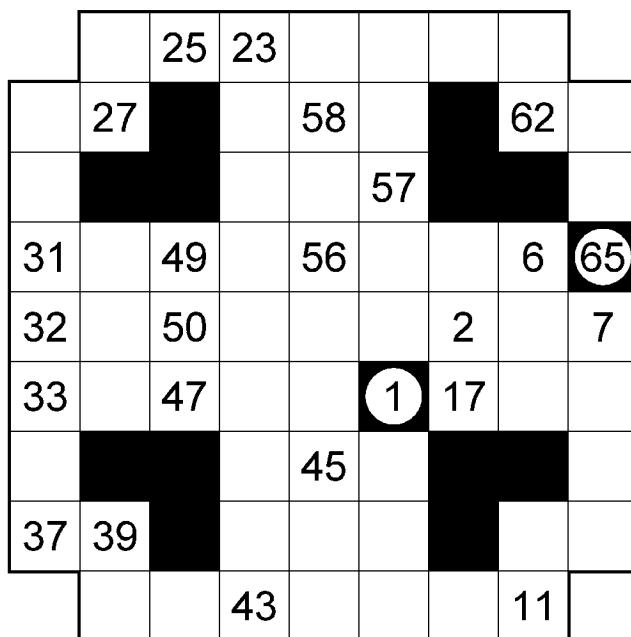

MASTER STROKES

BY PHIL FRANKE WITH TOP 100 GOLF INSTRUCTORS

A major component of good putting is having good “feel” of the putter in your hands. This can really benefit seniors who may have lost a little feel. The putting grip with maximum feel is called the “reverse-overlap” grip. With this grip, all the fingers of the right hand rest on the putter’s handle. Your left thumb is on the top of the grip with the last three fingers of that hand wrapped around the grip. The difference is that your left index finger is not on the grip but rather overlaps the fingers of the right hand. The advantage here is that having all the fingers of the right hand directly on the club gives you maximum feel for the stroke, which should act like a piston in pushing the clubhead toward the hole.
