SEPTEMBER 2, 2026

Possession of Stolen Property & Unauthorized Use of a Credit Card
 Police received a report of a vehicle break-in at a local hotel and a wallet was stolen. Witnesses provided descriptions of a male and female observed leaving the vehicle. Later that morning, the victim reported an attempted purchase using one of the stolen cards at a local retail business. Police located a 39-year-old male and a 38-year-old female matching witness descriptions. Both were charged with Possession of Stolen Property Under \$5,000 and Unauthorized Use of a Stolen Credit Card. The accused were released on appearance documents pending future court dates.

Concern for Public Well-Being

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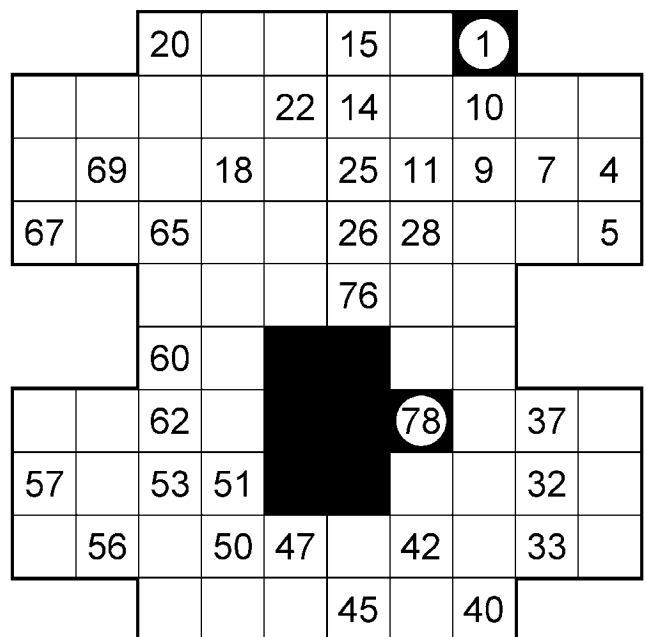

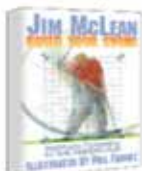

Don't Get All Wobbly on Us!

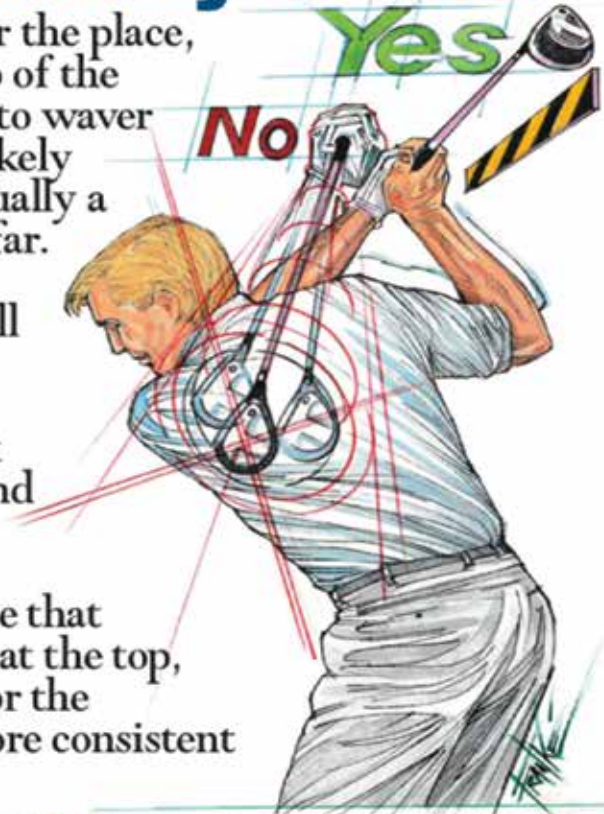
If you are hitting the ball all over the place, have someone watch you at the top of the swing. If the hands and club seem to waver or wobble at the top, this is most likely your problem. This wobbling is usually a result of trying to swing back too far. This extra "pull" to the top causes the club to wobble and starts to pull your lower body off-balance. Results: erratic shots!

The solution is simple: Swing back only as far as your left arm and hand can comfortably go.

Never try to reach back for more, looking for more distance. You'll see that the club shaft comes to a firm stop at the top, and you're poised and in balance for the downswing, producing more consistent and accurate shots.

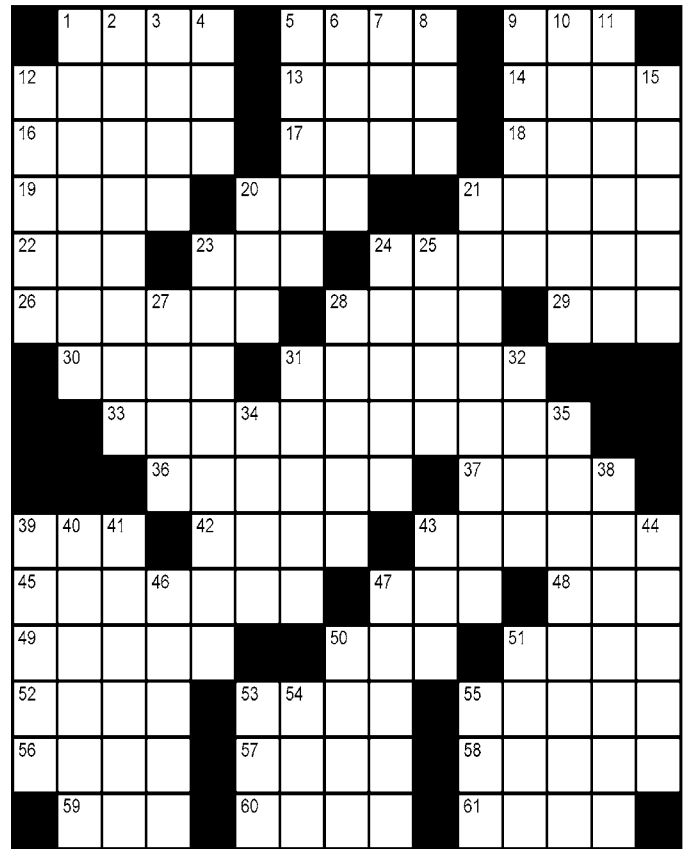

THE MORNING BITE

Refried Beans

One of my favorite dishes that works either as an appetizer or side dish is refried beans. A classic from Mexican cuisine, that is best eaten with some totopos or tortilla chips.

Ingredients

Two adult portions

400-500g can of pre-cooked beans

1/4 onion

3-4 garlic cloves

Cumin

Paprika

2-4 spoonfuls butter

Cooking oil (can be olive oil)



Directions

Add the oil and the butter to the frying pan and heat to medium heat.

Chop the onion and mince the garlic.

Once the frying pan is heated, add the onion and garlic to the pan, and fry them for about 3 minutes.

Add salt, cumin, and paprika to taste. Usually I add paprika until the mix is a brownish red. Mix with your spatula, and let fry for about 5 minutes.

Open the can of beans and pour the beans into the pan. Depending on how liquid you want the refried beans to be, you can use all or just some part of the liquid inside the can. I usually get rid of some of the liquid from the can before pouring the beans.

Mash the beans and mix. Let them fry at medium-low to medium heat for about 5 to 10 minutes, mixing from time to time.

Serve and enjoy.

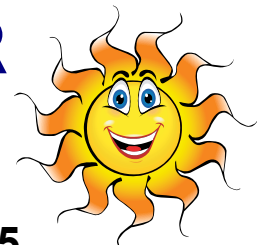

Burgar Funeral Home was started by Hiram Burgar in the back of his hardware store in 1906 - one of the first businesses in the Camrose community. After two years, his partner, Mr. Wallace withdrew from the business and his interest was taken over by Mr. Davidson, and was renamed Burgar, Davidson and company Hardware. When Davidson left the business in 1911, Burgar took over as the sole owner and in the same year Hiram and Maude (Wilson) were married. Three children were born in this union - Helen, Roderick and Doliena.

In 1917, Hiram sold his hardware store to concentrate full time on his funeral business and moved it to the present location. Rod joined his father in the business but in 1939 left to join the Canadian Air Force. After World War II ended, Rod returned to work in the funeral industry with his father. Soon after the firm name was changed to H. Burgar and Son.

When Hiram passed away in 1949, Rod and his wife Marg (Margaret) were left to manage the business. In 1959, Alver Person joined Rod Burgar and was employed at the time construction took place for the new Funeral Home.

In 1962, the sudden passing of Rod Burgar was a great shock to the community. His funeral service was one of the first to be held after the new building was dedicated, just two weeks prior to his untimely death.

Alver Person and Marg Burgar managed the business for the next few years, and in 1965, Alver purchased the business. The firm's name was then changed to Burgar Funeral Home Camrose Ltd., as it remains today.

Roger Erickson joined the firm and, in 1967 when he left to pursue other endeavors, Rod Madison began his career in the funeral service. Burgar Funeral Home was involved in the ambulance service from the very early years until 1971 when the City of Camrose assumed the responsibility. In 1979, the well-established Daysland Funeral Home was purchased by Burgar's. Bob Hanrahan, as manager, was associated with that funeral home for more than 70 years.

Reg Madison, Joe Schulte, and Steve Haugen were a part of Burgar Funeral Home and Alver's son, John, later joined the business, and served the community until 2017. Cam Parker joined Burgar Funeral Home in 1995 and served the community for 24 years. Bart Orr joined the firm in 2011 after the passing of his father introduced him to Cam and John.

Burgar Funeral Home is currently owned and operated by Bart Orr who, along with his dedicated team, are able to provide support to families in their time of need. We at Burgar Funeral Home
